

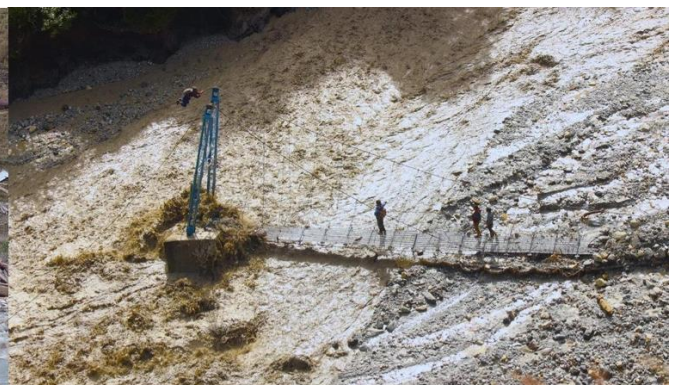

**AID PROJECT FOR SHELTER AND FOOD RELIEF
after devastating landslides and flash flooding**

Three municipalities in Mughu District in western Nepal are affected





After three days of heavy rain flashfloods and landslides caused devastating damage in several areas of western Nepal. In Mughu District the rains caused creeks and rivers to overflow turning the streams

into unstoppable torrents destroying everything in their path. The topsoil on the slopes was completely soaked with rainwater until it turned into deadly landslides tearing down homes and covering everything in heavy mud. Sixty people lost their lives, as well as sheep and other domestic animals. Two hundred houses were completely destroyed and many more are damaged. This is already the second heavy rain disaster in Nepal this year.

Dolpo Tulku Charitable foundation is planning to send relief materials to the the Chhayanath Rara, Soru and Khatyadh Municipalities in the district of Mughu where villages and families have been hit especially hard. A total of 236 homes have been completely destroyed there.

The relief assistance will include

- 1) Food supplies of rice, dhal and cooking oil.**
- 2) Corrugated tin sheets and zinc plates for roofing.**
- 3) Tents, blankets, clothing and drinking water.**

Corrugated tin sheets to help build shelters has been a very effective method to protect the homeless families from the elements. It is also a very helpful way to involve the local population in starting to build temporary shelter for their families as soon as possible.
